GROUND CAMPUS PROGRAMS

DENTAL ASSISTANT | Certificate Program

Acquire the skills needed to obtain patient histories, prepare and recalculate instruments, record dental exams, perform dental x-rays and assist dentists in a variety of dental facilities.

DIAGNOSTIC MEDICAL ULTRASOUND | Certificate or Associate's Degree Program

Master scanning protocols of the abdomen, superficial structures and obstetric/gynecology for procedures to be conducted in clinics, hospitals, acute or long-term care facilities.

LIMITED MEDICAL RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY | Certificate or Associate's Degree Program

Study the history, theory and application of diagnostic X-rays and acquire the skills necessary to pass the state licensing exam.

MASSAGE THERAPY | Certificate Program

Acquire the skills in body mechanics and massage techniques for entry-level employment as a massage practitioner in a variety of settings. *TX State License # MS0127.*

MEDICAL ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT | Certificate Program

Learn the administrative functions for the front office for a variety of medical facilities and acquire the basic skills and knowledge required for entry-level employment.

MEDICAL ASSISTANT | Certificate Program

Learn the skills to perform EKG's, injections, patient histories, vital signs, and acquire the knowledge to work in both front and back office of medical care facilities.

MEDICAL CODING & BILLING - HEALTH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY | Certificate Program

Learn to complete medical billing forms, file insurance claims, and maintain records according to current standards using the ICD-9 and ICD-10 coding system.
