Enrollment: Annual Enrollment is the total number of students enrolled in the program at any time during the year reported.

Reporting Year: July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 (Rates Effective November 2, 2022)

Retention Rate: Retention Rate is the number of students who graduated during, plus those who were still enrolled at the end of the reporting year as a percentage of the total number of students enrolled in the program at any time during the reporting year.

Placement Rate: The placement rate is a calculation of the number of graduating students who were employed in the field or related field for which they were trained by the program, as a percentage of all students who graduated from the program, not counting those unavailable for placement due to one of the following reasons, continuing education, health-related issues (including death), military obligations and/or incarceration.

Exam Pass Rate: The exam pass rate is reported where the only pathway to employment in the program is attempting and passing a license or credentialing examine as required by a regulatory body in a state in which the student or program is located; or the program is accredited by another agency that requires graduates to participate in a license or credentialing exam.

Enrollment: Annual Enrollment is the total number of students enrolled in the program at any time during the year reported.

Reporting Year: September 1, 2021 to August 31, 2022 (Rates Effective April 14, 2023)

Completion Rate: Completion Rate is the number of students who graduated as a percentage of all students who left school, not counting those who left because they entered other post-secondary education program, the military, or incarceration; or died.

Employment Rate: The employment rate is a calculation of the number of graduating students who were employed in the field that they were trained for by the program, as a percentage of all students who graduated from the program, not counting those who entered another post-secondary education program or the military, or were incarcerated, or died.

Placement Rate: The placement rate is a calculation of the number of graduating students who were employed in the field that they were trained in by the program, and actually placed in those jobs by the school, as a percentage of all students who graduated from the program, not counting those who entered another post-secondary education program or the military, or were incarcerated, or died.

OVERALL GRADUATION RATE

The overall graduation rate is also known as the "Student Right to Know" or IPEDS graduation rate. It tracks the progress of students who began their studies as **full-time, first-time degree- or certificate-seeking students** to see if they complete a degree or other award such as a certificate within 150% of "normal time" for completing the program in which they are enrolled.

Note that not all students at the institution are tracked for these rates. Students who have already attended another postsecondary institution, or who began their studies on a part-time basis, are not tracked for this rate.

BACHELOR'S DEGREES GRADUATION RATES

Bachelor's degree graduation rates measure the percentage of entering students beginning their studies full-time and seeking a bachelor's degree, who earn a bachelor's degree within a specified amount of time. **At this institution, 3 percent of the overall cohort were pursuing bachelor's degrees in 2016.**
